- 5. How would you describe the experience of working here?
- 6. What attracted you to working for this organization?
- 7. What have you liked most about working here?
- 8. How has the experience surprised or disappointed you?
- 9. If I were offered the opportunity to work with your organization, what would you like me to accomplish in my first ninety days?
- 10. If I were to be employed here, what one piece of wisdom would you want me to incorporate into my work life?
